

# BIKE RACK PROGRAM



**Don't let a lack of bicycle parking be the reason your customers or patrons ride on by!**

With a continually growing pathway and bicycle network, more Kelowna residents are using bicycles for transportation, recreation and leisure.

Now you can provide bicycle parking for your patrons and staff at a huge discount! The City of Kelowna Bicycle Rack Program will cover up to 50 per cent of the purchase and installation costs of a high quality bicycle rack in a publicly accessible area near you.



# Bike Rack Program

## Who is eligible?

Commercial businesses and institutions that attract visits from the general public.

## How much will it cost?

Bicycle racks can be quite costly; however, the City of Kelowna is offering, for a limited time, a subsidy that is equal to half the cost of an approved bicycle rack. This means that you can have a rack installed for as little as \$185 (includes installation by City crews). Through this program, installed racks range from \$185 to \$380, depending on design and capacity.

## What type of rack?

Urban Racks Bicycle Parking Systems is the City's official supplier of bicycle racks. They offer superior quality, durable, functional and aesthetically pleasing bike racks. The polyester plastic coating of these racks ensures an attractive, long-lasting finish, while the practical design allows for secure locking of the bicycle's frame and wheels. 'Hanger' style multi bike racks and 'inverted U' type racks are available.

## How do I apply?
